- 6. No public comments received
- There was a review of the Minutes of the July 11th, 2019 Board Meeting. Kenneth Bullington made a motion to 7. accept the minutes. Second made by Jerry Hinshaw. All members present voted yes to accept.
- Check Detail Report reviewed for dates 7/1/2019 through 7/31/2019, for check numbers 9962 through 10020, and 8. including electronic checks numbered 71519, 71619, 73119, and 243496. Also check sequence 1 and 2 from Spirit of Texas Bank to close the Comanche accounts. (These checks were deposited into the Stephenville bank accounts so were neither income nor expense.) Motion was made by Jerry Hinshaw, second by Shane Tucker, to approve and ratify the payment of the bills. All members present voted yes.
- Income/Expense Comparison was reviewed. 9.
- 10. Office Manager Report was given by Debbie Montgomery and Crystal Eberhart. In addition to the permit applications, there were 14 exempt well registrations. The MTGCD office will be closed on Monday, September 2nd, for Labor Day.
- Field Tech report was given by Johnny Wells. One well was plugged, in Comanche County. Nine water quality 11. tests were completed, 4 in Bosque County, and 5 in Erath County. All wells tested negative for bacteria. Coryell County wells were monitored in July and Bosque County will be monitored in August.
- 12. Education/Public Relations Report was given by Stephanie Keith. Events attended were discussed, along with plans for the recently purchased adjacent lot.
- 13. Manager's Report was given by Joe Cooper.
- 14. Crystal Eberhart went over the Current Tax Rate and Percent of Revenue Collected.
- 15. There was a second review of the budget.
- 16. Review/Discussion with Possible Action on Proposed Budget 2019 will be at September Board Meeting.
- 17. Approval of annual contract with Boucher, Morgan, and Young, CPA was discussed. Jerry Hinshaw moved to approve the contract, second by Kenneth Bullington. All members present voted yes.
- 18. A committee for the proposed Outdoor Classroom was appointed. Jerry Hinshaw, Shane Tucker, and Kenneth Bullington all volunteered for the committee, with Barbara Domel volunteering as an alternate.
- 19. The Regular Election for Directors from Bosque and Coryell Counties to be held November 5, 2019 was ordered.
- 20. Agenda items for the September board meeting include action on landscape architect proposal, ordering or
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cancelling the election, and adopting the tax rate and budget.
