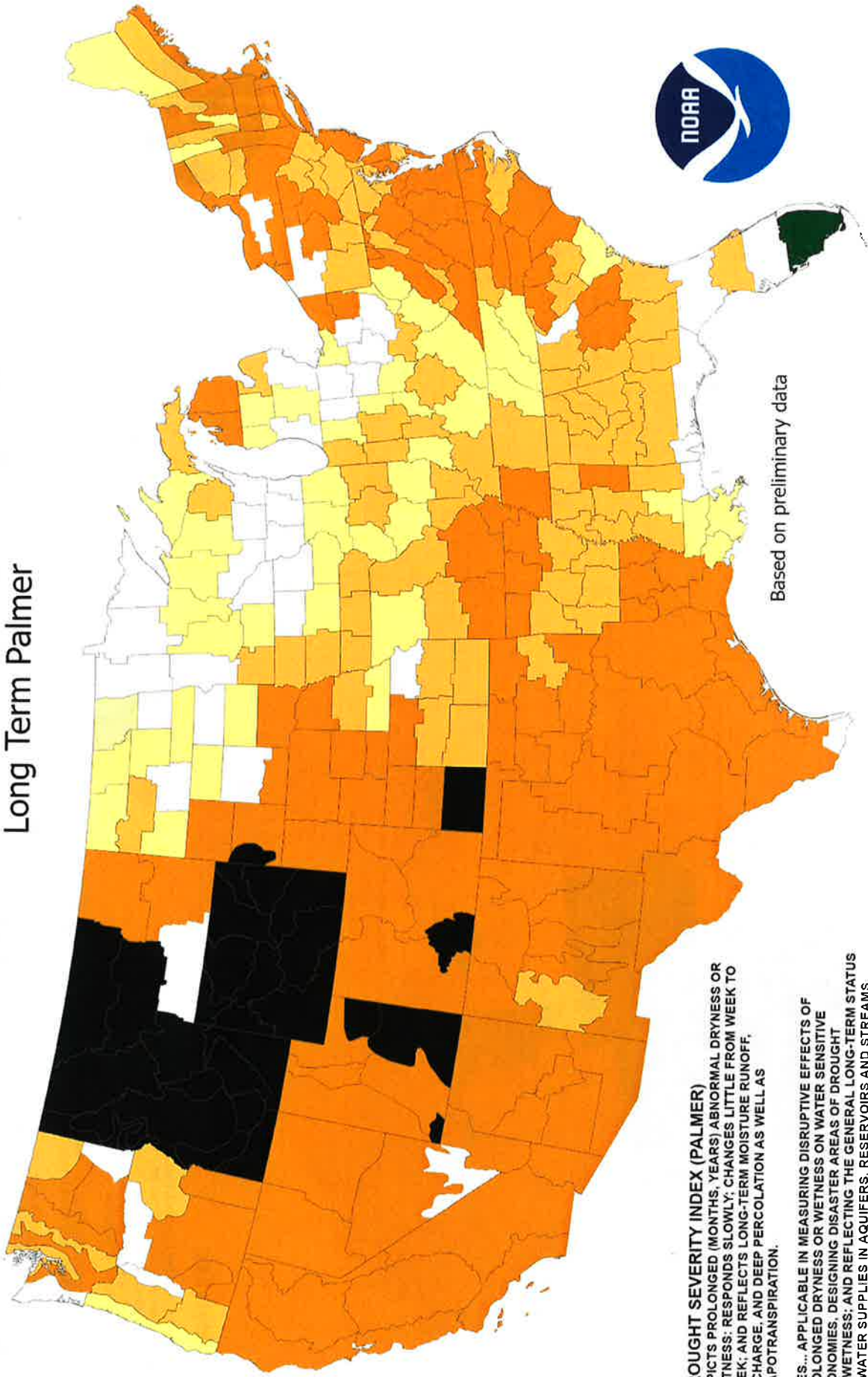

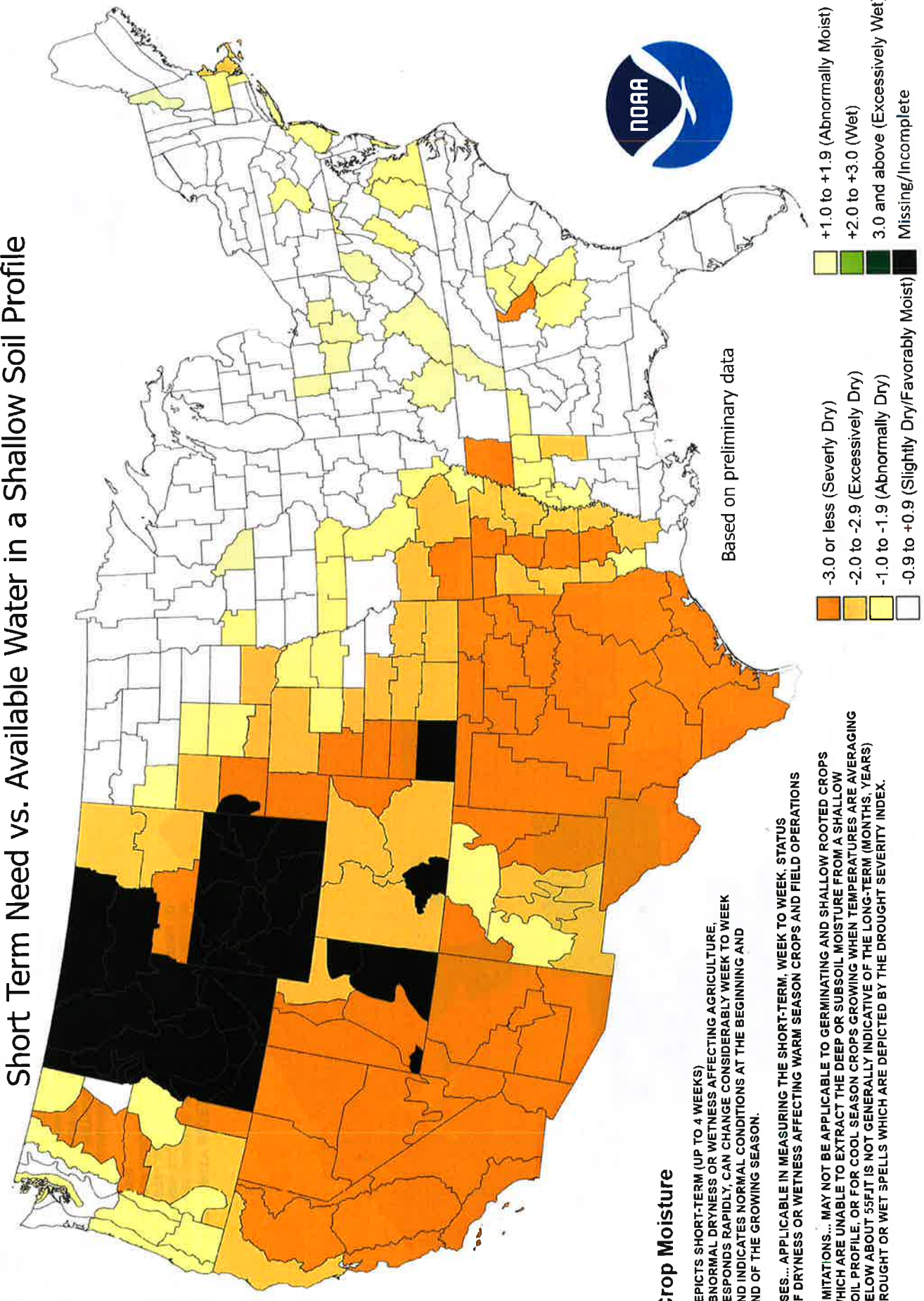

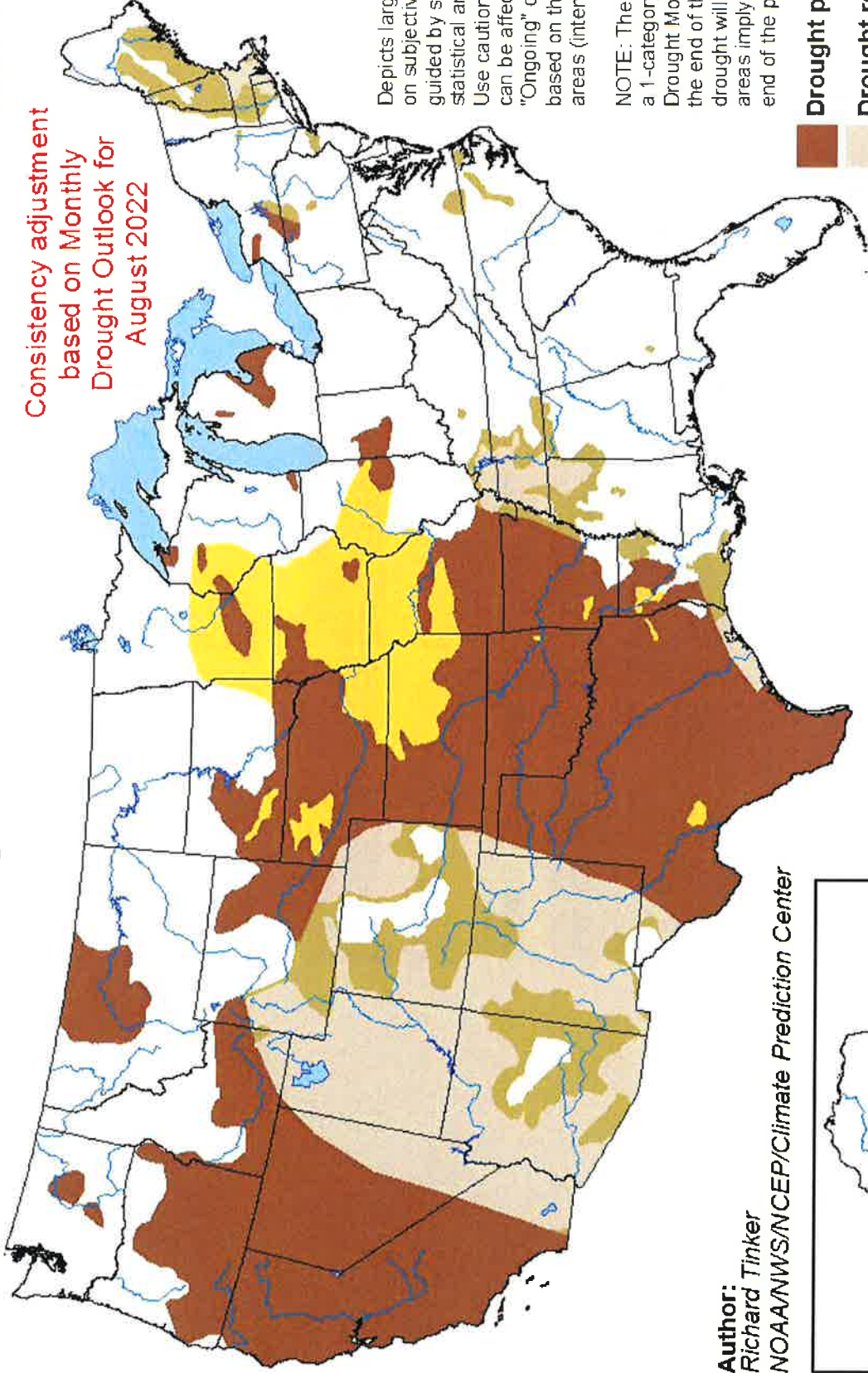

U.S. Seasonal Drought Outlook Drought Tendency During the Valid Period

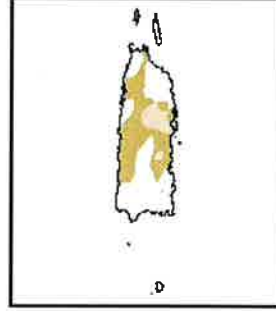
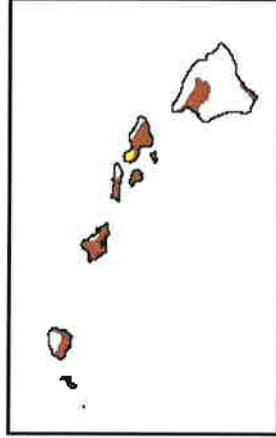
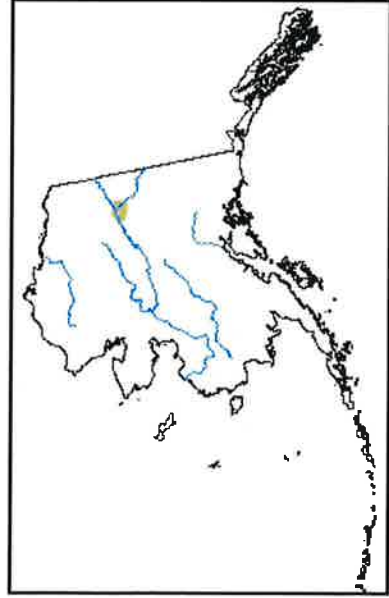

TexPool and TexPool Prime are currently rated AAAM by Standard & Poors, the highest rating a local government investment pool can achieve. The average monthly interest rate on MTGCD's invested public funds for July 2022 is 1.5205% for TexPool and 1.6723% for TexPool Prime. As of 7/31/2021, MTGCD has a total of \$ 3,457,992.99 invested at TexPool. A breakdown of MTGCD's TexPool accounts, including all investment transactions in the last quarter, is attached to this report.

ORDER CALLING GENERAL ELECTION OF DIRECTORS ON NOVEMBER 8, 2022

The Board of Directors ("Board") of the Middle Trinity Groundwater Conservation District (the "District") met in regular session, open to the public, after due notice, at 930 Wolfe Nursery Rd, Stephenville, Texas 76401 on Thursday, August 4, 2022; whereupon the roll was called of the members of the Board of Directors, to wit:

WHEREUPON, among other business conducted by the Board, Director, _____, introduced the order set out below moved its adoption, which motion was seconded by Director _____, and, after full discussion and the question being put to the Board of Directors, said motion was carried by the following vote:

"Aye" _____; "No" _____; and Abstaining _____.

The Order thus adopted is as follows:

WHEREAS, the 77th Texas Legislature enacted House Bill 3665, the enabling act for the Middle Trinity Groundwater Conservation District (the "District"), during the Regular Session in 2001 (Acts 2001, 77th Leg., R.S., Ch. 1362, eff. Sept. 1, 2001), which enabling act was subsequently amended by the 78th Texas Legislature (Acts 2003, 78th Leg., R.S., Ch. 893, eff. June 20, 2003) and the 81st Texas Legislature (Acts 2009, 81st Leg., R.S., Ch. 521, eff. June 19, 2009); and

WHEREAS, the District's enabling act was codified in Chapter 8863 of the Texas Special District Local Laws Code by the 83rd Texas Legislature (Acts 2013, 83rd Leg., R.S., Ch. 112, eff. Apr. 1, 2015); and

WHEREAS, Texas Special District Local Laws Code § 8862.055 requires the District to hold an election to elect directors from Bosque and Coryell Counties in each odd-numbered year; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 41.0052(a) of the Texas Election Code, the District changed its election date to the uniform election date in November by Order of the District's Board of Directors dated November 3, 2011; and

WHEREAS, Section 41.001(a) of the Texas Election Code establishes the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November as one of the uniform election dates for the State of Texas; and

WHEREAS, in the interest of increasing the efficiency and effectiveness of local governments, local governments may contract or agree with each other to perform governmental functions and services in accordance with Chapter 791 of the Texas Government Code; and

WHEREAS, Section 31.092 of the Texas Election Code authorizes the county elections officer to contract with the governing body of a political subdivision situated wholly or partly in the county served by the officer to perform election services in any one or more elections ordered by the political subdivision; and

WHEREAS, the District Board of Directors intends to enter into an Election Services Agreement with Bosque County for the provision of election services in Bosque County and intends to enter into an Election Services Agreement with Coryell County for the provision of election services in Coryell County; and

WHEREAS, in the event the Directors Election is uncontested, the Board of Directors will follow the procedures for election of unopposed candidate established by Section 2.051-2.054 of the Texas Election Code; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to provisions of the District's enabling act, Chapter 36 of the Texas Water Code, and the Texas Election Code, the Board wishes to proceed with the ordering of a Directors Election to be held on November 8, 2022.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF MIDDLE TRINITY GROUNDWATER CONSERVATION DISTRICT THAT:

Section 1: The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated into this Order for all purposes.

Section 2: An election shall be held by the District on the 8th day of November 2022 ("Election Day"), between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m., at which there shall be

submitted the question of the election of two (2) director to represent Erath County and one (1) director to represent Comanche County, each of whom shall serve four (4) year terms. All resident, qualified electors of Erath County shall be entitled to vote in the election for directors representing Erath County and all resident, qualified electors of Comanche County shall be entitled to vote in the election for a director representing Comanche County. The deadline for candidates to file applications to have their name on the ballot is 5:00 p.m. on August 22, 2022, and the deadline for write-in candidates to file a declaration of write-in candidacy is 5:00 p.m. on August 26, 2022.

Section 3: Voting in said election during early voting by personal appearance and on Election Day in shall be by the use of the DS200 voting system in Erath County and Hart voting system in Comanche County, which shall have available both English and Spanish and which shall conform to the requirements of the Texas Election Code. Oral bilingual assistance shall be available during the election and may be obtained by contacting the Election Judges.

Section 4: The Board of Directors of the District intends to enter into an Election Services Agreement with Erath and Comanche Counties for the conduct of the District Directors Election. Pursuant to the respective Election Agreements, the Erath and Comanche County Election Administrators will designate the Presiding Judges. The Presiding Judges may appoint, as they deem necessary, clerks to assist in the conduct of the election, not to exceed the maximum number of five (5).

Section 5: Early Voting and Election Day Voting

ERATH COUNTY:

Early voting by personal appearance in Erath County will be conducted each weekday at a location to be determined.

Early voting by personal appearance in Erath County shall begin on October 24, 2022, and shall continue through November 4, 2022, except for Saturdays, Sundays, and official state holidays.

Early voting shall be conducted between the hours of 9:00 am and 4:00 pm, except that extended hours for early voting will be held on October 24, 2022 and October 29, 2022, during which days early voting shall be conducted between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m.

Sharlene Talamantes shall serve as the Early Voting Clerk to conduct early voting in Erath County. Applications for ballots by mail and ballots to be voted by mail may be sent to the Early Voting Clerk via email to vote@co.erath.tx.us or via mail to Sharlene Talemantes, Elections Administrator, 100 W Washington Courthouse, 1st Floor, Stephenville, TX 76401. Visit the website at www.co.erath.tx.us/186/Current-Elections. Or call 254-459-5002. Applications for ballots by mail must be received no later than the close of business on October 28, 2022.

The District will use the Election Day polling locations as established by Erath County. Election Day voting in Erath County will be conducted at the following locations on Tuesday, November 8, 2022 from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

Section 6: The election shall be held and conducted and returns made to this Board of Directors in accordance with the Texas Election Code and Chapter 36, Texas Water Code.

Section 7: The Secretary of the Board is hereby directed to determine if the candidates are unopposed for election based on the following conditions:

(1) Only one candidate's name is to be placed on the ballot for each director position available; and

(2) No candidate's name is to be placed on a list of write-in candidates for the office of director.

If such circumstances exist, the Secretary of the Board shall certify in writing which, if any, candidates are unopposed for election to the office of director. The certification shall be delivered to the Board of Directors as soon as possible after the filing deadlines for placement on the ballot and list of write-in candidates. On receipt of the certification, the Board of Directors may declare each unopposed candidate elected to office, the election for that position will not be held, and a

copy of the order declaring the candidate elected shall be posted at the polling place on Election Day.

Section 8: To the extent the results of the election are not declared in accordance with Section 7 of this Order, the Secretary of the Board is hereby directed to provide notice of this election, in English and Spanish, by any one or more of the following methods in accordance with Section 4.003, Texas Election Code:

- (1) By publishing the notice at least once, not earlier than the 30th day or later than the 10th day before Election Day in a newspaper of general circulation in the territory if none is published in the jurisdiction of the authority responsible for giving the notice;
- (2) By posting, not later than the 21st day before Election Day, a copy of the notice at a public place in each election precinct that is in the jurisdiction of the authority responsible for giving the notice; or
- (3) By mailing, not later than the 10th day before Election Day, a copy of the notice to each registered voter of the territory that is covered by the election and is in the jurisdiction of the authority responsible for giving the notice.

In addition to the above methods of providing notice, the Secretary of the Board shall have notice of this election, in English and Spanish, posted not later than the 21st day before the election on the bulletin board used for posting notices of the meetings of the Board of Directors. Such notice shall remain posted continuously through Election Day.

Section 9: Pursuant to Section 31.123, Texas Election Code, the Secretary of the Board hereby appoints Patrick Wagner, Middle Trinity Groundwater Conservation District, 930 N. Wolfe Nursery Rd, Stephenville, Texas 76401 as the District's agent for this election.

Section 10: The Board President and Secretary are authorized to take all actions necessary to carry out the purposes of this Order.

**RESOLUTION

DESIGNATING DISTRICT REPRESENTATIVES TO PARTICIPATE IN
GROUNDWATER MANAGEMENT AREA 8 ACTIVITIES**

WHEREAS, the Middle Trinity Groundwater Conservation District (“District”) was created by the Texas Legislature, pursuant to the authority of Article XVI, § 59 of the Texas Constitution, through Act of May 25, 2001, 77th Leg., R.S., ch. 1362, 2001 Tex. Gen. Laws 3371, as amended (“the Act”), codified as Chapter 8862 of the Texas Special District Local Laws Code as a groundwater conservation district operating under Chapter 36, Texas Water Code, and the Act;

WHEREAS, § 35.004 of the Texas Water Code mandates that the Texas Water Development Board (the “TWDB”) designate and delineate Groundwater Management Areas (“GMAs”) (“Management Areas” as defined by § 35.002 of the Texas Water Code), within which groundwater conservation districts located partially or wholly within a particular GMA undertake joint planning efforts to manage the groundwater resources located within that GMA and other actions specified by § 36.108 of the Texas Water Code;

WHEREAS, the TWDB implemented Texas Water Code § 35.004 by adopting rules at Title 31, Chapter 356, of the Texas Administrative Code, and by designating and delineating GMAs, including GMA 8, as further detailed in § 356.21 of the Texas Administrative Code;

WHEREAS, GMA 8 includes territory within the jurisdiction of the Middle Trinity Groundwater Conservation District;

WHEREAS, the District desires to actively participate in joint planning in GMA 8 to achieve the objectives and meet the obligations set forth in § 36.108 of the Texas Water Code;

WHEREAS, the District, including its Presiding Officer, desires to designate a representative and an alternate designee to participate and represent the District in GMA 8’s activities, in accordance with § 36.108 of the Texas Water Code; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors, including the District’s Presiding Officer, upon proper notice and in an open meeting, seeks to take formal action to designate a representative and an alternate designee to participate and represent the District in GMA 8’s joint planning activities.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

1. The recitals above are true and correct.

2. The Board of Directors, including the District’s Presiding Officer, hereby designates Patrick Wagner as the District’s representative to participate on the District’s behalf at meetings and other activities of GMA 8, and to fulfill the obligations of a District Representative under § 36.108 of the Texas Water Code. Mr. Wagner shall be empowered to represent the District and take any and all necessary actions at GMA 8 to protect the District’s interests, including but not limited to voting, serving as an officer of GMA 8, and otherwise exercising leadership and participating in the joint planning efforts of GMA 8.

3. The Board of Directors, including the District’s Presiding Officer, hereby designates Charles E. Ferguson as an alternate representative. In the event that Mr. Wagner is unavailable to participate in a particular activity of GMA 8, Mr. Ferguson may participate in his absence. While serving in Mr. Wagner’s absence, Mr. Ferguson shall be authorized to take any and all action that Mr. Wagner has been authorized to take by this Board resolution.

4. The Board of Directors further instructs these designated representatives to advise the District’s staff whenever the districts located in whole or in part in GMA 8 schedule a joint planning meeting to allow the District’s staff sufficient time to post public notice of the GMA meeting, in accordance with the Water Code and the Texas Open Meetings Act.



Re: Scope and Fee to Assess Well Spacing

Dear Mr. Wagner:

As requested, Advanced Groundwater Solutions, LLC (AGS) has developed a proposal to assess drawdown associated with pumping wells located in the outcrop and downdip portions of the Trinity Aquifer throughout the four counties of the Middle Trinity GCD.

Task 1: Assess hydraulic properties

1. Gather data and calculate statistics for transmissivity and storativity estimates in the outcrop counties (Erath and Comanche) and the downdip counties (Bosque and Coryell).
2. As appropriate in aquifers where sufficient data is available, histograms or other statistical graphs of hydraulic properties will be developed to show the variation in transmissivity and storativity (or specific yield in unconfined aquifers) as well as the mean and standard deviation of the estimates. If possible, data will be grouped by dominant aquifers in each area (Paluxy, Glen Rose, Hensell, Pearsall, and Hosston).

Task 2: Assess pumping impacts

1. **Single Well Analysis:** For each aquifer, use average transmissivity and storativity estimates to calculate drawdown from a single pumping well from 1 to 500 feet away from well and illustrate effectively. Calculate drawdown at 1 hour, 1 day, and 1 month. If data is available, perform the same analysis for “low” and “high” transmissivity and storativity estimates as well. Low and high estimates will be based the amount of data available, with the goal being to show the potential variation in each aquifer in each area.
2. **Multi-Well Analysis:** Repeat the single well analysis for regularly spaced wells in a grid pattern to simulate the impact of overlapping cones of depression from many wells producing at the same time. The goal is to assess impacts from a well pattern that might be required for a subdivision. Spacing of the well grid will be 200, 400 and 600 feet. Results will be illustrated for each aquifer in each area.

PROJECT SCHEDULE

AGS is prepared to initiate work immediately upon receipt of written authorization to proceed from MTGCD. A technical memo describing the work and results can be provided within 90 days.

Drought Contingency Plan

Re-Adopted August 4th, 2022

I. Purpose and Policy of Drought Contingency Plan

The Middle Trinity Groundwater Conservation District (“District”) re-adopts this Drought Contingency Plan (“Plan”) to further its efforts of conserving, preserving, and managing the groundwater resources within the District’s boundaries. The purpose of this Plan is to minimize the effects of depletion of the groundwater resources in the District during times of drought. The District believes that the voluntary reductions in usage that are associated with each drought stage in this Plan can be achieved and will minimize the effects of drought on the District’s groundwater resources. Nothing in this Plan prevents the District from exercising its authority under Chapter 36 of the Texas Water Code, the District’s enabling legislation, or the District’s Rules.

II. Designation of Drought Stages

The District Board of Directors (“Board”) or the District General Manager shall determine when conditions warrant initiation or termination of each drought stage in this Plan and shall take appropriate action to declare the appropriate stage. In the event the General Manager declares a drought stage in accordance with this Plan, the Board shall be informed of the action taken to declare a drought stage at the next District Board meeting. The Board may confirm or revise the action taken to declare a drought stage if considered to be necessary by the Board.

III. Public Notification of Drought Stages

Public notification of the initiation or termination of declared drought stages may be accomplished by using any one or more of the following methods:

- a. Notification on the District’s internet website;
- b. Publication in newspaper(s) of general circulation in the District;
- c. District mailing, fax, or email to owners/operators of permitted wells.

IV. Criteria for Initiation and Termination of Drought Stages

Initiation of a Drought Stage: The Precipitation Deficit Index (PDI) shall be monitored and presented to the District Board at each monthly Board meeting. PDI is monitored every Monday at 8:00 A.M., on a running-year basis over a defined area consisting generally of the District’s four counties (Erath, Comanche, Bosque, and Coryell) and based on NEX-RAD rainfall data provided by the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration. The PDI is listed in the drought stages in this Plan as a percentage of average rainfall. Drought

stages shall be triggered when the PDI value is less than a drought stage trigger condition for the period described below:

The PDI must be less than the drought state trigger condition of the drought for a period of 30 consecutive days.

Termination of a Drought Stage: The drought stage in effect shall be reduced or terminated when the PDI is greater than the trigger conditions of the drought stage in effect for the periods described below:

The PDI must be greater than the trigger condition for a period of 42 consecutive days.

V. Public Water Suppliers

The District recognizes that public water suppliers within the District have Drought Contingency Plans that provide drought stages and drought stage reduction measures that are intended to apply within their service areas. All public water suppliers within the District that have Drought Contingency Plans have the discretion as to how the desired usage reduction is to be accomplished within their service areas.

VI. Drought Stage Conservation Measures

The goals and usage reduction measures assigned to each drought stage below are voluntary and are recommended for the purpose of reducing the impact of drought conditions on the groundwater resources within the District's boundaries.

Stage 1 – Mild Drought Status

Drought Stage Trigger: PDI = 70 to 79%

Goal: 10% reduction in water use

Recommended Actions to Reduce Water Usage:

- a. Check for and repair all water leaks.
- b. Install aerators on faucets.
- c. While waiting for hot water to reach faucet, catch cold water in a container to be reused.
- d. Limit landscape irrigation to no more than two days per week. Agriculture and horticulture operations are exempted from this measure but are encouraged to reduce tree, plant, and crop watering by 10%.
- e. Do not leave faucets running when not in use.
- f. Turn off master water shutoff when out of town or on vacation.
- g. Check automatic sprinkler heads regularly to prevent clogging and adjust to eliminate overspray
- h. Avoid watering on windy days.
- i. Use mulch to conserve soil moisture.

- j. Limit vehicle washing except when conducted with a bucket or hand-held hose with an automatic shutoff device during and, if possible, use a commercial car wash that recycles water.
- k. Limit swimming pool filter backwashing to only when necessary.
- l. Utilize water reuse or recirculation where possible.
- m. Limit landscape irrigation to occur only between the hours of 9:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m.

Stage 2 – Moderate Drought Status

Drought Stage Trigger: PDI = 60 – 69%

Goal: 20% reduction in water use

Recommended Actions to Reduce Water Usage:

- a. Follow all actions under Stage 1 – Mild Drought Status.
- b. Use water to wash down buildings or other structures only for the fire protection purposes or for public health and safety purposes.
- c. Limit landscape irrigation to no more than one day per week. Agriculture and horticulture operations are exempted from this measure but are encouraged to reduce tree, plant, and crop watering by 20%.
- d. Keep swimming pools, landscape or decorative ponds and fountains covered where possible, re-circulate water, and refill only once per week.
- e. Water livestock in leak-proof troughs as much as practical.
- f. Limit the use of ornamental fountains, ponds for aesthetic or scenery purposes only where absolutely necessary to support aquatic life or where equipped with a recirculating system.
- g. Use soaker hoses for foundation protection only on designated watering days.
- h. Water for dust control only where required by law.
- i. Wash down sidewalks, walkways, driveways, parking lots, tennis courts or other hard-surfaced areas only for public health and safety purposes.

Stage 3 – Severe Drought Status

Drought Stage Trigger: PDI = 50 to 59%

Goal: 30% reduction in water use

Recommended Actions to Reduce Water Usage:

- a. Follow all actions under Stage 1 – Mild Drought Status and Stage 2 – Moderate Drought Status
- b. Limit all outdoor watering to the use of a hand-held hose with an automatic shutoff device or faucet-filled bucket or watering can.
- c. Do not refill swimming pools, landscape or decorative ponds and fountains.
- d. Limit all washing of vehicles, boats, or trailers to commercial carwashes that recycle water.

Stage 4 – Emergency Drought Status

Drought Stage Trigger: PDI < 50%

Goal: 40% reduction in water use

Recommended Actions to Reduce Water Usage:

- a. Follow all actions under Stage 1 – Mild Drought Status, Stage 2 – Moderate Drought Status, and Stage 3 – Severe Drought Status.
- b. Limit all outdoor use of water and nonessential uses as much as possible.
- c. No landscape irrigation or outdoor watering. Agriculture and horticulture operations are exempted from this measure but are encouraged to reduce tree, plant, and crop watering by 40%.
 - a. No washing of vehicles, boats, or trailers.

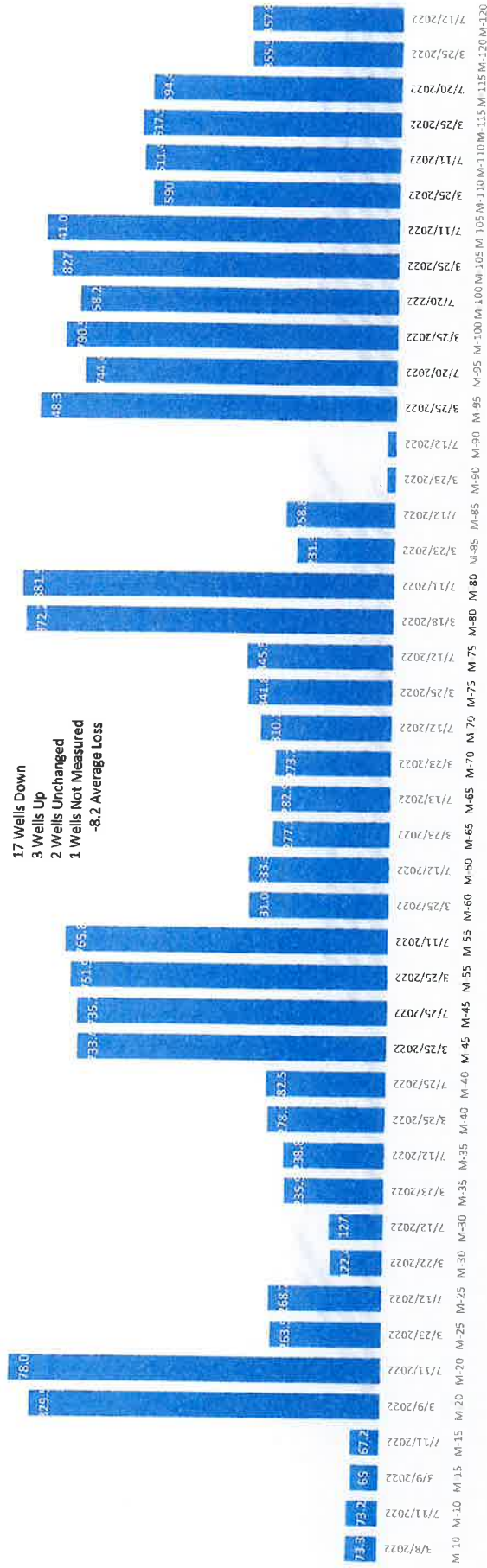

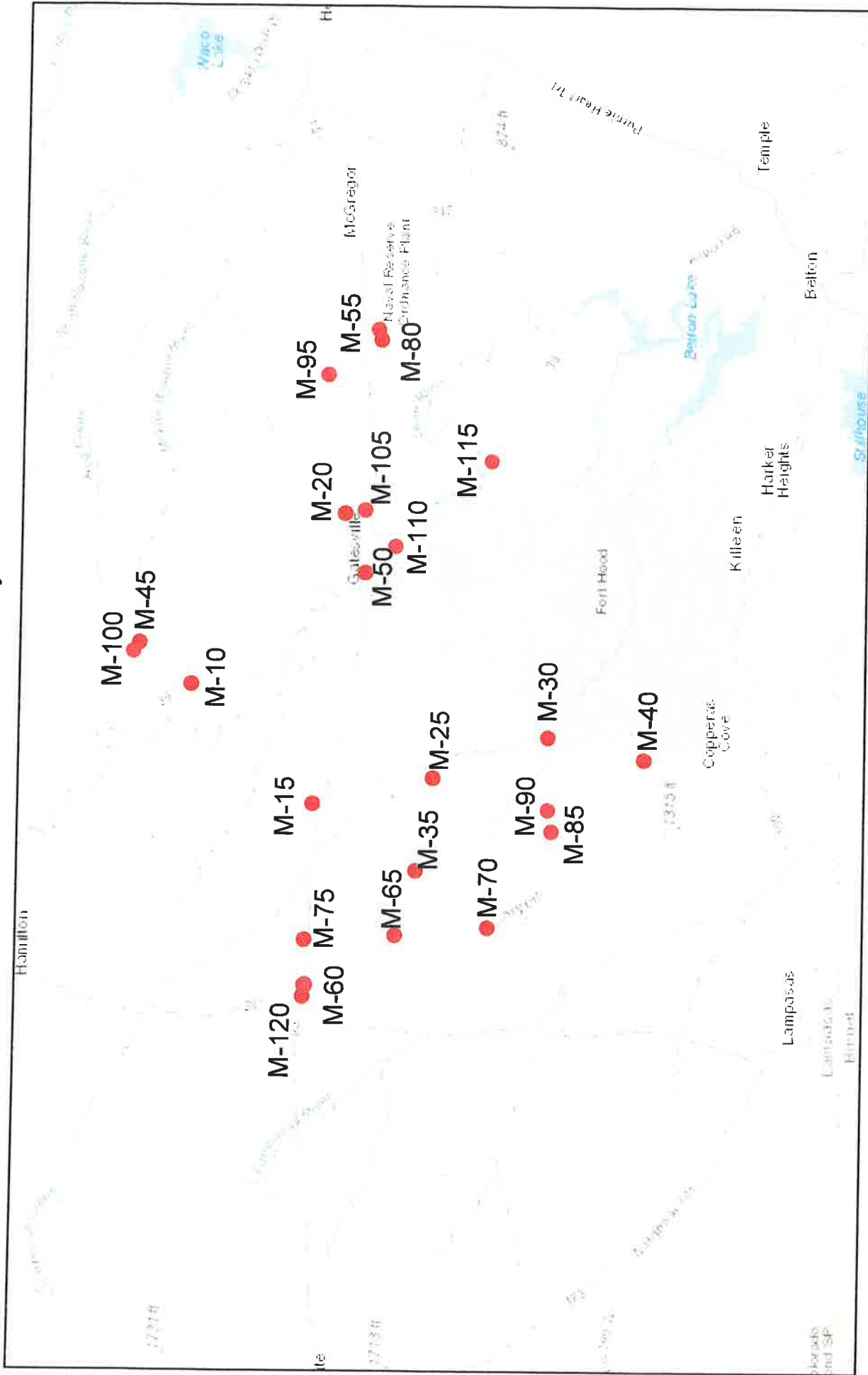

MTGCD Monthly Drought Report 2022 – August

Assessment of the U.S. Drought Monitor, Palmer Drought Severity Index (PDSI), Crop Moisture Index (CMI), and Drought Probability Predictions follow:

U.S. Drought Monitor:

The U.S. Drought Monitor¹ as of July 26th, 2022, for the MTGCD is between drought conditions D3 (extreme drought) and D4 (exceptional drought). All portions of each county are under drought conditions. Erath and Comanche counties are in extreme drought, all of Bosque and Coryell counties under exceptional conditions.

Palmer Drought Severity Index: (MGMT Plan Objective E.2.)

The PDSI as of July 30th, 2022, for the North Central Texas region is -7.72 which translates as **extreme drought**. Last month's value: -5.77.

Crop Moisture Index: (MGMT Plan Objective E.2.)

The CMI, as of July 30th, 2022, for the North Central Texas region is -7.50, indicating that soil moisture is **severely dry**, approaching excessively dry. Last month's value: -5.49.

Drought Probability Predictions: (MGMT Plan Objective E.2.)

The Climate Prediction Center of NOAA updated its U.S. seasonal outlook on July 31st, 2022, with predictions through October 31st, 2022. The map indicates that current **drought conditions will persist** throughout the MTGCD.

MTGCD Drought Cast: (MGMT Plan Objective E.1.)

MTGCD Drought Cast as part of the Drought Contingency Plan (DCP), uses NEX-RAD rainfall data provided by the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration over a 365-day total. Broken out amongst the four (4) counties: Bosque, Comanche, Coryell, and Erath. All four counties are in Drought Stage 3. Information attached.
