Thirteen water quality tests were completed, 10 in Erath County, and 3 in Comanche County. One Erath County well tested positive for bacteria. It was a hund-dug well and will be re-tested. Comanche County wells were monitored in June and Coryell County wells will be monitored in July.
- 16. Education/PR Report/The Ditch Water Discovery Center Update given by Patrick Wagner, in Stephanie Keith's absence.
- 17. Monthly Drought Report given by Patrick Wagner.
- 18. Monthly Investment Report given by Patrick Wagner.
- 19. There was a second look at the 2023 Budget.
- 20. There was discussion of the Tax Rate for the upcoming year. Certified totals should be received soon.
- 21. There was no Executive Session.
- 22. There was discussion on agenda items for the August Board Meeting.
