RULE 7.2 ADHERENCE TO LOCATION IN PERMIT:

After an application for an Operating Permit has been granted, the well, if drilled, must be drilled within 10 (ten) yards (30 feet) of the location or alternative location specified in the Operating Permit, and not elsewhere. If the well should be commenced or drilled at a different location, the drilling or operation of such well may be enjoined by the Board pursuant to Chapter 36, Texas Water Code. As described in the Texas Water Well Drillers and Pump Installer Administrative Rules, *16 Texas Administrative Code § 76.1000*, all well drillers and persons having a well drilled, deepened, or otherwise altered shall adhere to the provisions of the rule prescribing the location of wells and proper completion.

RULE 7.3 SPACING AND LOCATION OF WELLS:

Location of all new exempt or non-exempt wells should be as specified in *16 Texas Administrative Code § 76.1000* (Tex. Dept. of Lic. and Reg., *Technical Requirements – Locations and Standards of Completion for Wells*).

RULE 7.4 SPACING AND LOCATION OF NEW PERMITTED WELLS:

(a) In addition to the requirements in Rule 7.3, the following well spacing shall be required for the drilling of new wells that require an Operating Permit:

Well casing Diameter	Minimum distance from existing registered or or permitted wells and between proposed wells
Up to 4"	300 ft.
>4" up to 5"	400 ft.
>5" up to 6"	500 ft.
>6" up to 7"	600 ft.
>7" but less than 8"	700 ft.
8" but less than 10"	800 ft.
10" or greater	1000 ft.

(b) An applicant may seek an exception to the spacing requirements of Subsection (a) of this Rule on the grounds that the well or wells proposed in the application will produce groundwater from an aquifer or subdivision thereof other than the aquifer or subdivision thereof from which the existing permitted or registered wells that are closer than the minimum distances are producing. The exception may be granted by the Board only after written notice of a permit hearing has been given by the applicant to all owners of existing permitted or registered wells located within the minimum required distance from the proposed permitted well site, and after a public hearing at which all interested parties have the opportunity to appear and be heard.

An applicant may also seek an exception to the spacing requirements of Subsection (a) of this Rule if the applicant presents waivers signed by all landowners and water well owners whose property or wells would be located within the applicable minimum distance established under these Rules from the proposed well site stating that they have no objection to the proposed location of the well site. The General Manager, may waive certain spacing requirements for the proposed well location and notify the Board at the next scheduled Board meeting. The General Manager reserves the right to present any exception application at the next scheduled Board Meeting that the General Manager determines to need Board approval.

(c) For purposes of this Rule, a permitted or registered well is “existing” if it has already been authorized by the District or if the District has received an administratively complete application for the well.

(d) In addition to the requirements set forth under Subsection (a) of this Rule, a well for an applicant

RULE 11.6: WELL REGISTRATION AND PERMIT APPLICATION PROCESSING

Well registrations and any permit-related applications shall not be accepted for filing or processing or hearings scheduled until receipt by the District of all applicable fees established by Board resolution; nor will any application be accepted for filing or processing if the applicant, driller, operator, or owner of the well:

- (1) is delinquent in paying any fee required or outstanding judgement obtained by the District;
- (2) has been properly notified of a possible rules violation or a pending enforcement action for a substantive violation of a District permit, order, or rule that has not been settled by agreement with the District or a final adjudication; or
- (3) has not paid a civil penalty, has otherwise failed to comply with an order resulting from a final adjudication of a violation of a District permit, order, or rule or a judgment from a court of proper jurisdiction.

Any change in the identity of a driller on any well registration or permit-related registration must be communicated and approved by the ~~District~~ General Manager

SECTION 12: TRANSPORT OF GROUNDWATER

RULE 12.1 GROUNDWATER TRANSPORT FEE:

No permit other than a Grandfather Permit or an Operating Permit is required to transport groundwater produced in the District for use outside of the District. However, the District may impose a reasonable fee or surcharge for transportation of groundwater out of the District in an amount not to exceed 20 cents per thousand gallons of groundwater to be transferred out of the District. Effective January 1, 2024, the maximum allowable rate the District may impose for an export fee or surcharge under this Rule increases by three percent each calendar year. An export fee or surcharge imposed, or an increase in an imposed export fee or surcharge, is not valid unless it is approved by the Board after a public hearing.

A permittee who transports groundwater for use outside of the District shall be metered in accordance with Rule 13.1, keep a monthly log of meter readings of groundwater produced and transported out of the District, and shall provide the District with a report of monthly and annual groundwater produced and transported for the previous calendar year on a form provided by the District no later than January 15 of each year.

RULE 12.2 AMENDMENT OF PERMIT:

In accordance with Rule 5.14(c), the permit under which the groundwater will be transported must be amended to reflect any change in location or type of use of the water produced.

SECTION 13: METERS AND VOLUNTARY METERING PROGRAM

RULE 13.1 METERS REQUIRED FOR CERTAIN WELLS:

- (a) A meter is required for the production or transport of any groundwater for use inside or outside of the District for any activity for which a fee that is based on the amount of groundwater produced or transported is required to be calculated under these Rules. The owner of a well required to be metered under this Rule shall equip the well with a flow measurement device meeting the specifications of these Rules and shall operate the meter on the well to measure the cumulative

20. Failure to report meter readings on water transported out of the district (Rule 12.1(b) & 13.5)

23. Failure to meter wells as part of Voluntary Metering Program – (Rule 13.6)
24. Failure to report meter readings as part of Voluntary Metering Program - (Rule 13.6)
25. Manipulation of, tampering with, or removal of meters that are part of Voluntary Metering Program – (Rule 13.6(e)(8))
26. Exceeding production limit for wells that are part of Voluntary Metering Program – (Rule 13.6(e)(9))

VIII. Civil Penalty Schedule for Major Violations

First Violation:	\$5200.00
Second Violation:	\$10400.00
Third Violation:	Civil suit for injunction and damages

A second violation shall be any rule violation that occurs within 5 years of the first violation of the same level. A third violation shall be any violation which follows the second violation within 5 years of the first violation. Each day of a continuing violation constitutes a separate violation within the violation class. For example, operating a well without a permit for 10 days would constitute ten separate "First Violations" of the Rules. After litigation or settlement with the District for that series of violations, if the same person again operated a well without a permit within 5 years of the dates of the first series of illegal well operations, each day of the subsequent violations would constitute separate "Second Violations."

IX. Minor Violations

The District deems the following acts as Minor Violations:

1. Operating a well without registering the well – (Rule 5.2(a))

2. Failure to register a well that is completed or subject to change in type or location of use - (Rule 5.2(a))
3. Failure to amend registration – (Rule 5.2(k))
4. Failure to cap a well to prevent waste, prevent pollution, or prevent further deterioration of a well casing or capping of well not adequately done - (Rule 11.5)
5. Failure to plug an abandoned or deteriorated well - (Rule 11.5(b))
6. Failure to notify District of change of ownership of well - (Rules 5.2(k) and 5.12(b))
7. Failure to timely renew an Operating Permit - (Rule 5.5(d))
8. Failure to complete the Groundwater Well Status Report - (Rules 5.12(k) / Rule 5.17)

X. Civil Penalty Schedule for Minor Violations

First Violation:	\$1050.00
Second Violation:	\$2100.00
Third Violation:	Major Violation

A second violation shall be any rule violation that occurs within 5 years of the first violation of the same level. A third violation shall be any violation which follows the second violation within 5 years of the first violation. Each day of a continuing violation constitutes a separate violation within the violation class (see example under Section VIII above).

XI. Other Violations of District Rules Not Specifically Listed Herein

Any violation of a District Rule not specifically set forth herein shall be presented to the Board of Directors for a determination of whether the violation is Minor or Major, based upon the severity of the violation and the particular facts and issues involved, whereupon the procedures and the appropriate civil penalty amount set forth herein for Minor and Major Violations shall apply to the violation.

Aggressive' hurricane forecast for Gulf Coast

Colorado State University researchers are calling this year's hurricane season forecast "the most aggressive" ever, the Texas Standard reported. They say there is a 54% chance a hurricane will strike the Texas coast, and a 25% chance it will be major.

Justin Ballard, the Houston Chronicle's newsroom meteorologist, told the Texas Standard that the last hurricane to make landfall was Nicholas in 2021. The last major hurricane to land was Harvey in 2017, which caused \$125 billion worth of damage.

"These storms are becoming, yes, more common, more intense, but they're also becoming more destructive with the amount of damage that they can cause just because things are more expensive," Ballard said.

Ballard is urging Texas residents, especially those new to the coast who have never experienced a hurricane, to consider gradually stocking up on nonperishable items such as water and canned goods, rather than waiting until a hurricane threatens the Gulf of Mexico.

TPWD sued in attempt to block land swap with SpaceX

The Texas Parks and Wildlife Department is being sued in an attempt to block a land swap deal with SpaceX in South Texas, kut.org reported. TPWD in March approved pursuing an exchange of 43 acres of Boca Chica State Park to the company in exchange for nearly 500 acres of land that is now privately owned. SpaceX is negotiating to buy the land in order to make the swap with TPWD.

The South Texas Environmental Justice Network, the Carrizo/Comecrudo Tribe of Texas

and Save RGV filed the lawsuit in a Travis County district court in early April. SpaceX wants the land swap in order to expand its launch facility near the state park. The suit alleges TPWD violated statutory requirements to ensure mitigating harm to the land and considering alternatives to giving up park land.

Patrick lists legislative priorities for 2025 session

Lt. Gov. Dan Patrick has a to-do list of 57 items for senators in the next legislative session, The Texas Tribune reported, including improving housing affordability, fighting antisemitism on college campuses, and examining charitable bail organizations.

"Come January 2025, the Senate will hit the ground running at the start of the 89th Legislative Session," Patrick said in a statement. "The priorities of the conservative majority of Texans will be accomplished, including school choice, continued property tax relief, and strengthening the power grid."

Patrick said he wants his chamber to recommend how to "reduce regulatory barriers" and "strengthen property rights," that could possibly reduce city land use and zoning rules.

He also wants the criminal justice committee to examine the practices of charitable bail organizations, which pay bonds to release defendants unable to do so on their own. Additionally, he wants senators to review university policies to ensure they prevent antisemitism while preserving free speech rights, The Tribune reported.

Law requiring voter registration in high schools ignored

Texas high schools are required to distribute voter registration forms to teens who turn 18 or are about to do so, but only about a fourth of schools are doing so, according to an estimate from the University of Houston's Election Lab. The law was passed in 1983, according to The Tribune, but many administrators are unaware of its existence. The state has about 409,000 18-year-old citizens, according to 2022 census data.

The secretary of state's office, which was tasked with creating the instructions to implement

the law, does not track compliance. Schools who fail to comply are not penalized.

State oil, gas production hits record highs in 2023

The state set new records for oil and gas production last year, according to the Texas Railroad Commission, which regulates the industries and tallies production reports submitted by the state's operators.

In 2023, the state produced 1.92 billion barrels of oil, eclipsing the record set in 2019 of 1.86 billion barrels. Gas production totaled 12.01 trillion cubic feet in 2023, breaking the previous record of 10.61 trillion cubic feet set in 2021.

"These production records are beyond impressive and reflect how Texas continues to provide reliable domestic production for the nation," said Wei Wang, RRC executive director. "As the state's oil and gas regulator, the RRC is committed to our critical mission supporting Texas' economic growth that benefits Texans. Production taxes collected from the oil and gas industry pay for our schools, highways and the state's Rainy Day Fund."

Senate race will be expensive, reports indicate

Republican U.S. Sen. Ted Cruz and Democratic challenger U.S. Rep. Colin Allred each raised more than \$9 million in campaign contributions during the first quarter of 2024, the Austin American-Statesman reported. Cruz is seeking his third six-year term in the Senate, while Allred gave up a safe congressional seat to challenge him. He is in his third term in the House.

Both sides touted the fundraising results as proof of the strength of their respective campaigns. In 2018, Cruz raised about \$50 million while defeating his Democratic opponent, former U.S. Rep. Beto O'Rourke of El Paso, who raised \$80 million.

An item last week regarding a legislative hearing on the recent Panhandle wildfires misidentified the committee chair. The special committee is chaired by Rep. Ken King, R-Canadian.

The activity is funded under the CDBG Program and administered by the TDA ERR #(CDV23-0345). The City proposes a Water Infrastructure Improvements project, including Administrative and Engineering fees and services, for improvements at three water wells and two water connection sites. The improvements to the water wells will consist of replacing aged pumps, improving the site and electricals, and complete all associated appurtenances. 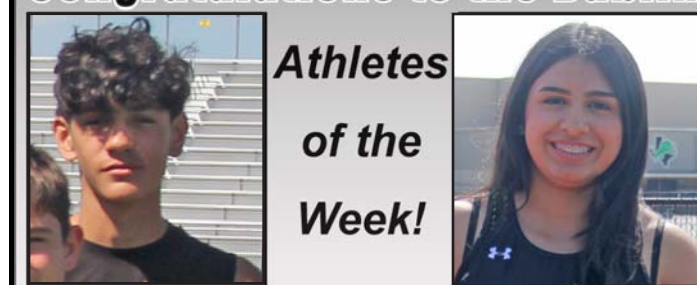

MTGCD Monthly Drought Report 2024 – May

Assessment of the U.S. Drought Monitor, Palmer Drought Severity Index (PDSI), Crop Moisture Index (CMI), and Drought Probability Predictions follow:

U.S. Drought Monitor:

The U.S. Drought Monitor¹ as of April 30, 2024, for the MTGCD is between drought conditions None and D0 (**abnormally dry**). Bosque, Coryell, and Erath Counties have no drought conditions. Comanche ranges from none to abnormally dry.

Palmer Drought Severity Index: (MGMT Plan Objective E.2.)

The PDSI as of April 27, 2024, for the North Central Texas region is 1.91 which translates as **near normal**. Last month's value: 1.20.

Crop Moisture Index: (MGMT Plan Objective E.2.)

The CMI, as of April 27, 2024, for the North Central Texas region is 1.58, indicating that soil moisture is **favorably moist**. Last month's value: 0.41.

Drought Probability Predictions: (MGMT Plan Objective E.2.)

The Climate Prediction Center of NOAA updated its U.S. seasonal outlook on April 30, 2024, with predictions through July 31, 2024. The map indicates no drought in the long term.

MTGCD Drought Cast: (MGMT Plan Objective E.1.)

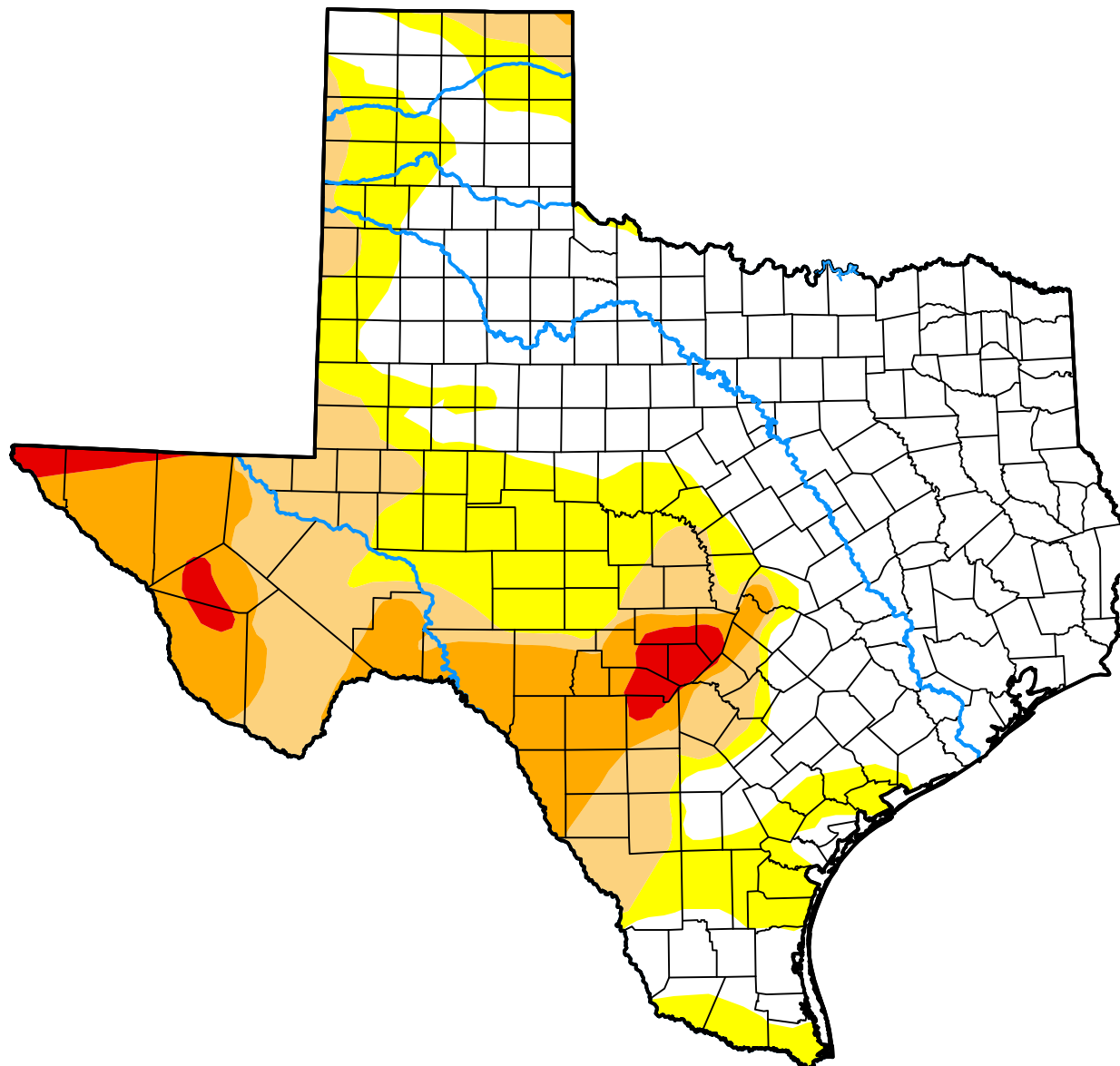
MTGCD Drought Cast as part of the Drought Contingency Plan (DCP), uses NEX-RAD rainfall data provided by the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration over a 365-day total. Broken out amongst the four (4) counties: Bosque, Comanche, Coryell, and Erath. All counties are currently not in a Drought Stage per the DCP.

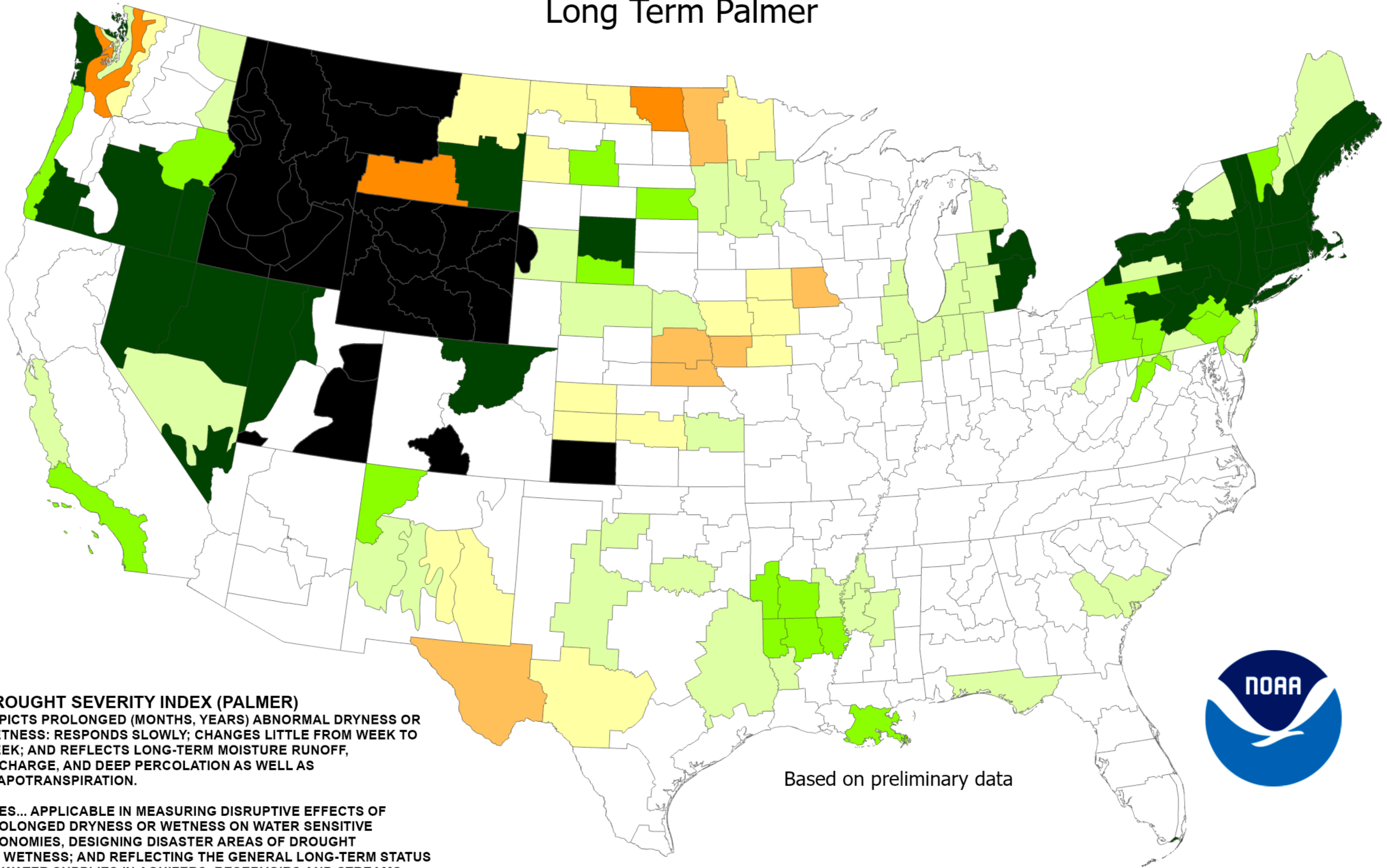

DROUGHT SEVERITY INDEX (PALMER)







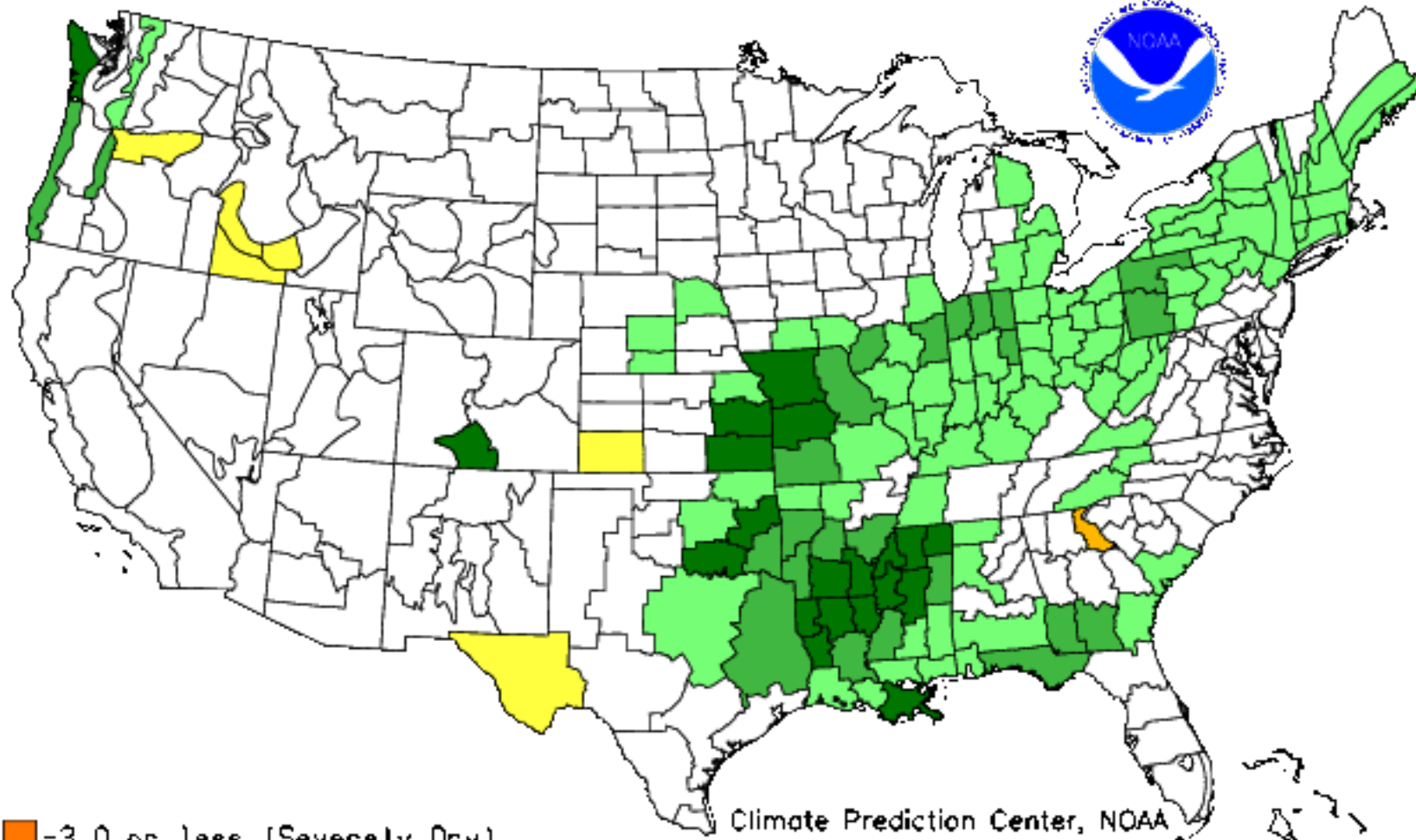

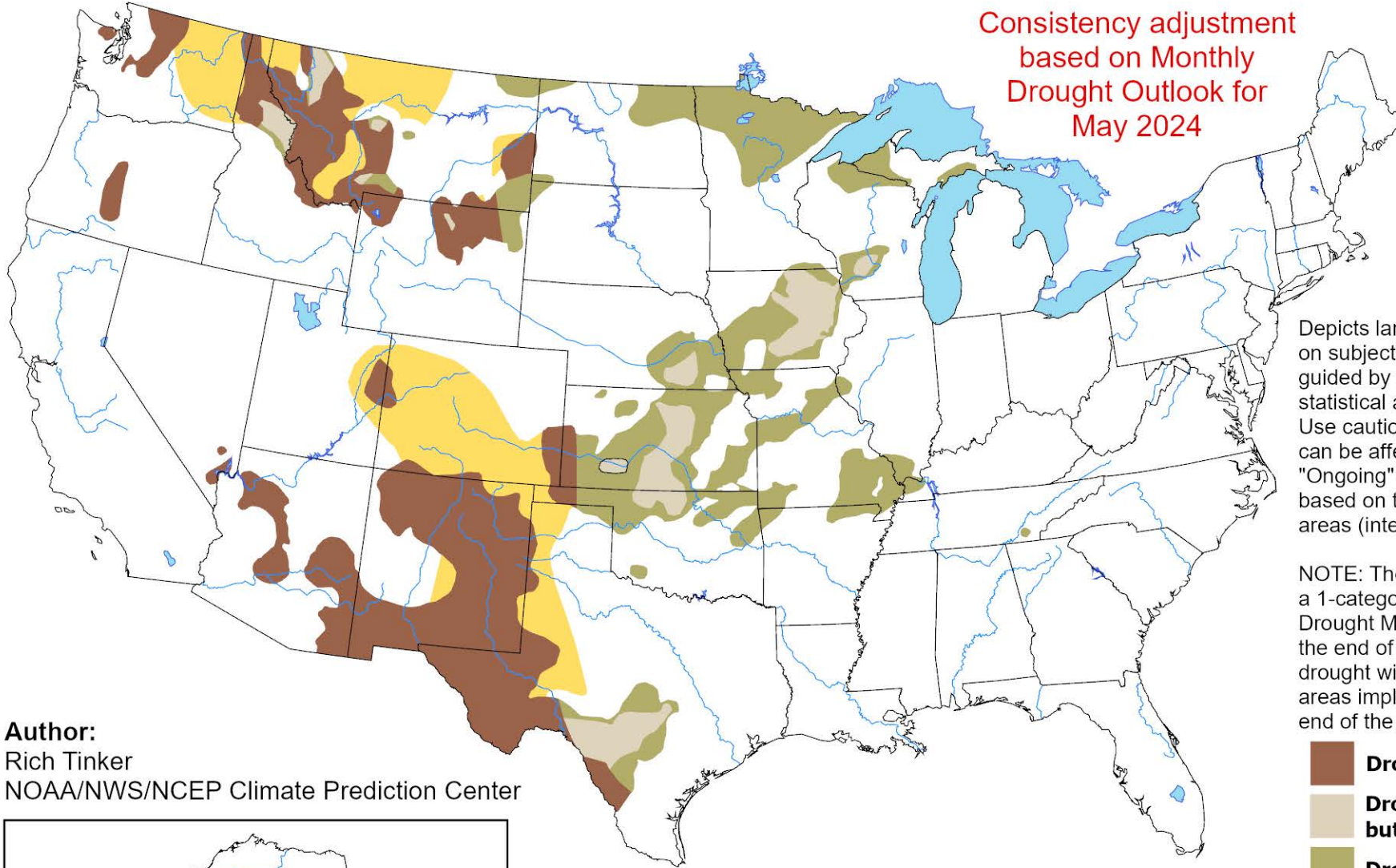
U.S. Seasonal Drought Outlook
