- 3. Roll Call of Members was given by Debbie Montgomery.
- 4. Pledge of allegiance was conducted.
- 5. Guest present was Paul Gaudette of the Dublin Citizen.
- 6. No public comments were received
- 7. There was a review of the Minutes of the September 5<sup>th</sup>, 2019 monthly Board Meeting. Kenneth Bullington made a motion to approve the minutes, second by Shane Tucker. All members present voted yes to accept the minutes. There was also a review of the Minutes of the September 5<sup>th</sup>, 2019 Tax Rate Meeting. Frank Volleman made a motion to accept the minutes, second by Kenneth Bullington. All members present voted yes to accept.
- 8. Check Detail Report reviewed for dates 9/1/2019 through 9/30/2019, for check numbers 10092 through 10140, and including electronic checks numbered 19915-19917, 83319, 83120, and 193009. Motion was made by Kenneth Bullington, second by Jerry Hinshaw, to approve and ratify the payment of the bills. All members present voted yes.
- 9. Income/Expense Comparison was reviewed.
- 10. Office Manager Report was given by Crystal Eberhart and Debbie Montgomery. In addition to the permit applications, there were 16 exempt well registrations. Operating Permit Renewals have been mailed out, due back to the MTGCD office by October 31, 2019. The MTGCD office will be closed on Monday, October 14, 2019 in observance of Columbus Day.
- 11. Field Tech report was given by Johnny Wells. Eight wells were plugged, 1 in Comanche County and 7 in Erath County. Four water quality tests were completed, all in Erath County. One well tested positive for bacteria. It was a new well, was bleached and rechecked and was okay. Erath County wells were monitored in September and Comanche County wells will be monitored in October.
- 12. Education/Public Relations Report was given by Stephanie Keith.
- 13. Manager's Report was given by Joe Cooper.

- 14. Quarterly Investment Report given by Joe Cooper. The average monthly interest rate on MTGCD's invested public funds for September 2019 is 2.1635% for TexPool and 2.2749% for TexPool Prime. MTGCD currently has a total of \$3,591,004.51 invested with TexPool.
- 15. Quarterly Drought Report given by Joe Cooper. The Palmer Drought Severity Index (PDSI) as of September 28, 2019 for the North Central Texas region is -1.29, which translates to "near normal" conditions. The Crop Moisture Index (CMI) for the North Central Texas region is -2.73, which translates to "excessively dry." The U.S. Seasonal Drought Outlook on September 19, 2019 with predictions valid through December 31, 2019 indicates that drought conditions persist in our area.
- 16. There was discussion on Central Appraisal District Voting Allocation for Comanche and Coryell Counties. No nominations were received for Coryell County. Shane Tucker made a motion to nominate Jason Pate for Comanche County, second by Frank Volleman. All members present voted yes.
- 17. There was discussion on adding a Budget Line Item for the Outdoor Classroom. Jerry Hinshaw made a motion to amend the budget to add a budget line item for \$70,000 for the outdoor learning center, making the total budget \$841,210. Second by Kenneth Bullington. All members present voted yes.
- 18. There was discussion on the date for the December Board Meeting. December Meeting date will be Thursday, December 5<sup>th</sup>, 2019 at 5:00 PM at Rathbone Hall in Comanche, Texas.
- 19. Agenda items for the November Board Meeting were discussed, including a subcommittee report on the Outdoor Learning Center.
- 20. Motion to adjourn made by Fred Parker. Second by Shane Tucker. Meeting adjourned by Rodney Stephens.
